Someone with the audacity to perform in three rings







Haggadah/Seder

Matthew 15:1-20

1. Kadesh -- Blessing of the wine (wine/grape juice is poured):
Exodus 6:6-7: “

2. Urchatz -- Washing of hands.

3. Karpas -- The vegetables (maror) are dipped into the karpas and let to drip, symbolizing the tears of the Hebrews under bondage.

The youngest son will then ask the Four Questions:

1. Why is this night different from all other nights?
2. On all other nights we eat leavened or unleavened bread, but this night only unleavened bread.
3. On all other nights we eat all kinds of herbs, but this night only bitter herbs. Why do we dip the herbs twice?
4. On all other nights we eat meat roasted, stewed, or boiled, but on this night why only roasted meat?

4. Yachatz -- The breaking of bread (matzah).

5. Maggid -- The head would answer these questions and recite the Exodus Story (Acts 7:2-28).

6. Rachtzah -- Second hand washing and blessing over the second cup

7. Motzi -- Blessing over the grain of the Matzah.

8. Matzah -- Break off a piece and eat it.“

9. Maror -- The maror (usually horseradish) is dipped in the charoset.

10. Korech -- The third piece of matzah and chazeret is dipped into the charoset and a pray is recited.

11. Shulchan Orech -- The main feast of the Passover is eaten.

12. Tzafun -- The afikomen is “found” and consumed, said to represent the journey of Israel from slavery to freedom.

13. Barech -- The third cup of wine is poured out; “I will redeem you with an outstretched arm....” It was here Jesus likely said “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

Jeremiah 31:31-21: “

14. Hallel -- The recitations of the Hallel Psalms (Psalms 113-118). The fourth cup *is poured and consumed.*

15. Nirzah -- “Next year in Jerusalem!”




